Communion Prayer

One: Let us pray: Source of Life and Creativity whom we name God, we are gathered together in this sacred place to offer praise and thanksgiving.
Many: We remember your covenant with your people Israel, which came to fruition in the life and ministry of Jesus. We remember his words and deeds, that wherever he came, people rediscovered their humanity, became filled with new meaning and purpose, and found a new courage to live, not just for themselves but for others as well.
